HOW TO GO TO THE TRACK



— BYROAD

From Bologna

Bologna is the nearest metropolis, only about 60 kilometres from Imola. Once you arrive in Bologna from any direction, take the A14 (Autostrada Adriatico) motorway heading to Ancona. After about 35 kilometres, you will reach the Imola motorway exit. The journey will take about 25 minutes.

If you want to save on tolls, you can take the parallel state road SS9. The journey will take about 45 minutes but can be significantly longer in heavy traffic.

From Bologna, take the A14 motorway towards Borgo Panigale, turn onto the E45 motorway and head east, leave the Imola exit and follow the signs to the Enzo e Dino Ferrari Autodromo. The journey takes approximately 42 minutes.

From the Adriatic coast and its resorts

The key is always to get on the A14 Adriatic motorway, which is always the most convenient way to get to the Enzo e Dino Ferrari circuit in Imola. Be sure to avoid the longer crossings on the coastal SS16 national road. Traffic is usually very slow on this road, and it's usually 60mph at most.

From Florence

From the Tuscan capital, head north on the A1 motorway, the Autostrada del Sol. There are two versions of this road - the modern one and the original twentieth-century one. The new one will take you very quickly through the Apennine mountains. However, choose the older version if you have time and want to enjoy the spectacular views of the Tuscan countryside and the winding old-school curves. Tolls are the same on both roads.

On arrival in Bologna, join the city ring road and then the A14 Autostrada Adriatico. The journey to Imola takes less than two hours.

Attention! You may find it tempting to head to Imola via the Apennines on the regional road SR302. While it looks tempting, it is actually narrow, often broken and, above all, winding. You'll shave 60 kilometres off your journey, but you'll spend an hour more on it.

From Venice

Take the A13 and E45 southbound, exit the motorway at the Imola exit and follow the signs to the Enzo e Dino Ferrari Autodromo. The journey will take nearly two hours.

From Milan

Take the A1 motorway until just before Bologna, where you will exit directly onto the Autostrada Adriatico A14 in the direction of Ancona. This will then take you to Imola, and you can bypass Bologna on the bypass. You will spend about 2:45 hours on the road unless there is the usual traffic in Bologna



— BYBUS

A number of buses also run to Imola. You can find the exact routes on the Trenitalia app, where you can

also buy a ticket and download it to your mobile phone. However, keep in mind that buses will be in the same queue as cars when arriving at Imola. If you can, we recommend using trains rather than public transport

HOW TO GO TO THE TRACK



— BY TRAIN

Italy's state-owned Trenitalia railway is one of the most comfortable and developed in Europe. They offer a wide range of connections, from high-speed trains to regional services. If you don't need to travel by car, this is clearly the best way to get to the Formula 1 race in Imola.

From Bologna

There is a direct service from Bologna Centrale Station, which takes 20 minutes to Imola. From the station, you can reach the Enzo e Dino Ferrari circuit in about 30 minutes, or take a taxi. The service runs every 30 minutes and costs in the order of units of euros. You can buy your ticket online on the Trenitalia website.

From Bologna airport

If you are travelling from the airport, use the Marconi Express. It takes seven minutes to Bologna Centrale Station. Then take the regular service.

Fast trains from Rome, Venice, and Milan

Other Italian cities - Venice, Milan and, of course, Rome - also offer very fast train connections. From Rome, for example, the train to Bologna takes just 2 hours and 23 minutes. By car, it is four and a half hours. Prices and timetables can be found on the Trenitalia website.

From the Adriatic coast (Rimini, Misano Adriatico)

There are also very good train connections from resorts on the Adriatic coast, such as Rimini, Misano Adriatico and others. The train ride takes about 50 minutes. This is a great option for those who don't want to stay near the ring road and pay the increased prices



— BY PLANE

There are several international airports in the vicinity of Imola, the closest, of course, being Bologna, which offers connections to a number of European destinations. You can also use the large airports in Venice or Florence. For travel from non-European destinations, the most common airport is Milan.

Bologna Airport is connected to bus and train services that take you to Imola. The more distant airports offer very comfortable connections to Bologna via high-speed trains, but these are quite expensive.

Forlì Airport is only about 30 kilometres from Imola. However, it just offers regional connections around Italy, with regular international flights only to Tirana in Albania and Lodz in Poland.

Rimini's medium-sized airport, about an hour from the Enzo e Dino Ferrari circuit, offers more options

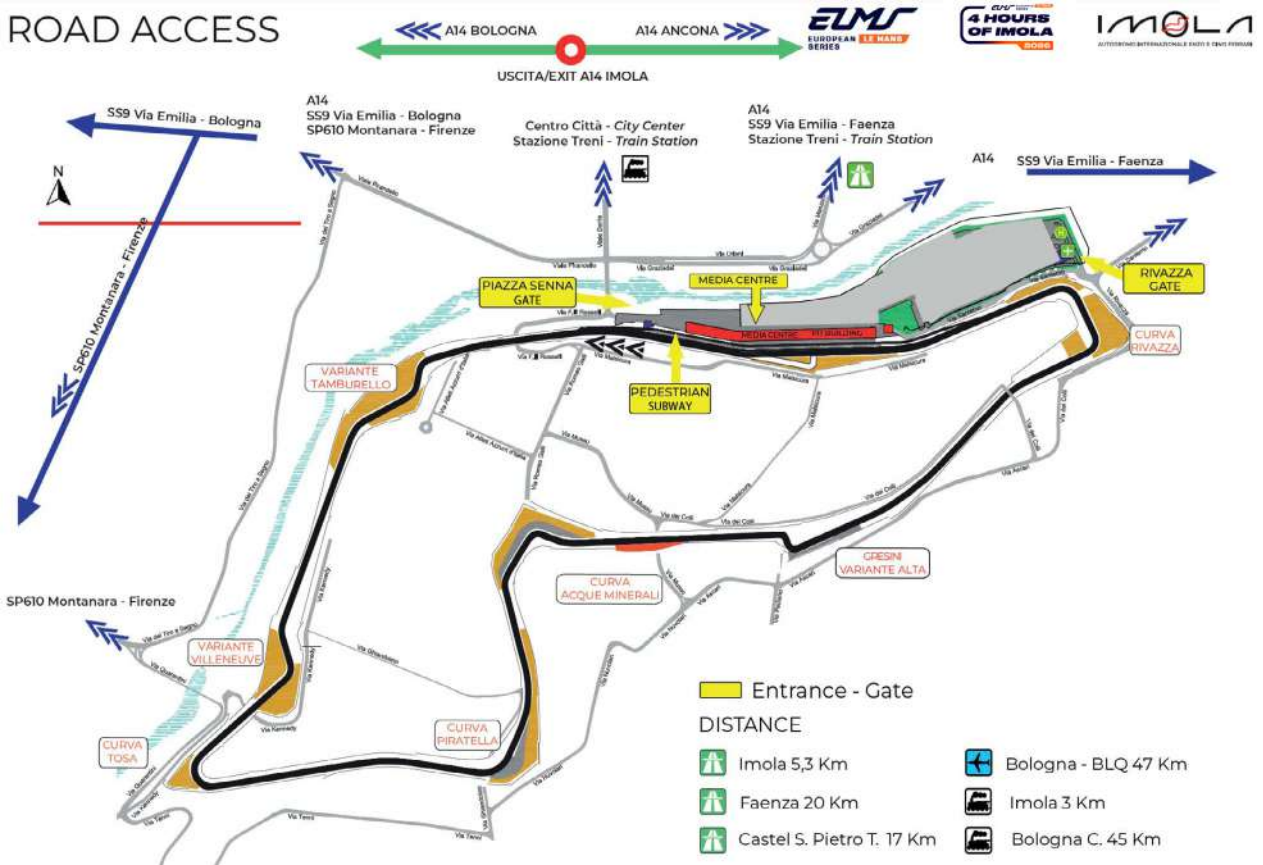

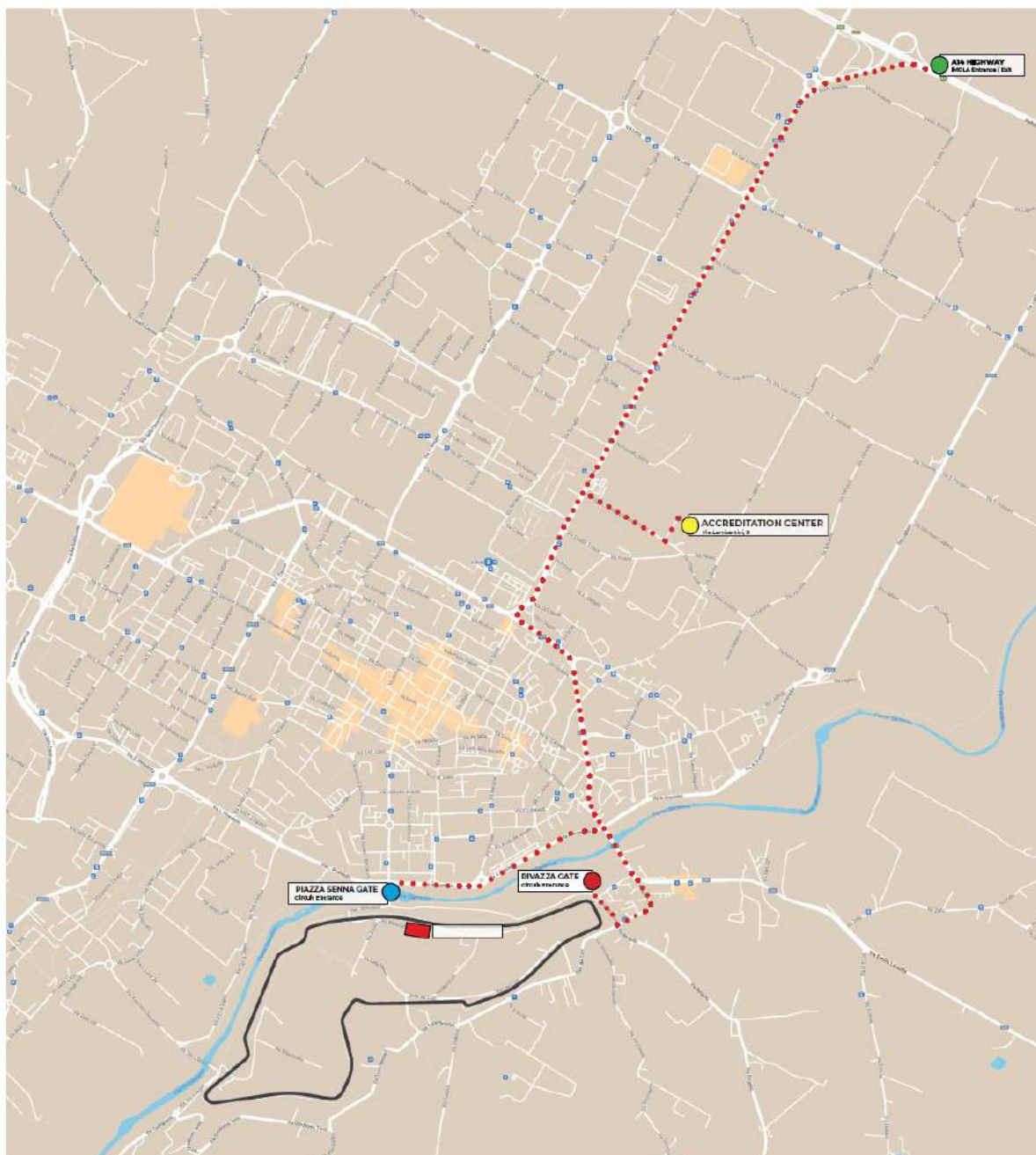

MEDIA CAR PARK - P2

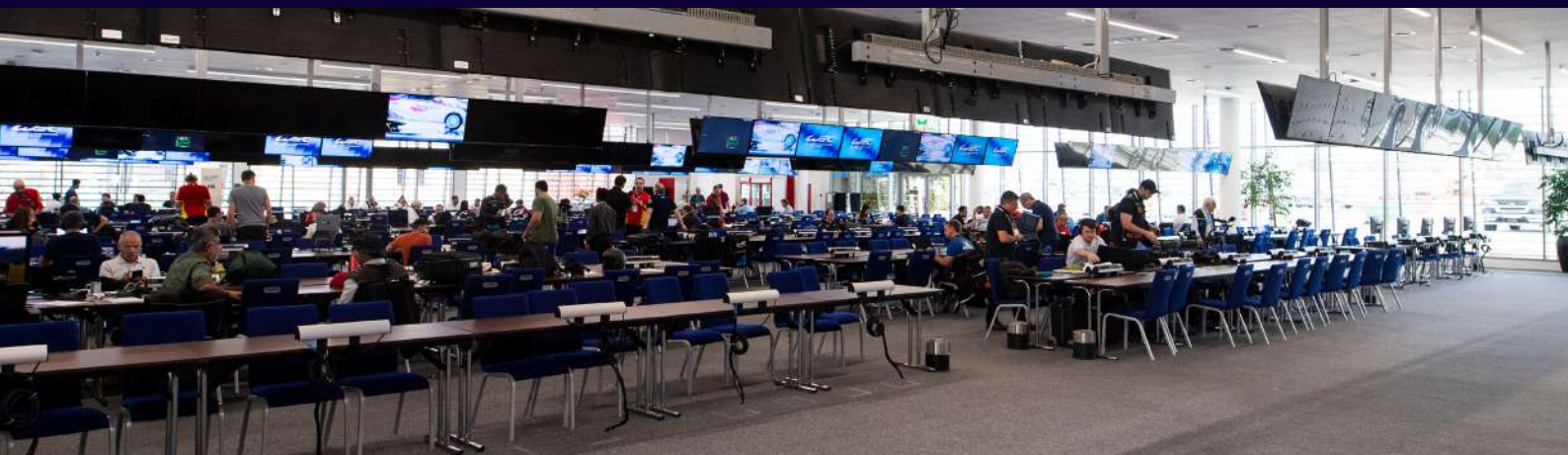
For this weekend, the Media Car Park is the **P2**.

Season passes who already attended this safety briefing in Barcelona, don't need to do it again.

MEDIA INFORMATIONS



WORKING IN THE PIT LANE

Pitlane access is strictly limited and is granted to photographers who need to access the area. Please note that the access to this area is limited for safety reasons. The requests will be evaluated and the priority will go to media working whether for a team, a driver or a media outlet involved in the championship.

All photographers and TV crews working in the pitlane are required to wear a fireproof overall to the standard FIA 8856-2000 or FIA 8856-2018 (no other fireproof is acceptable) and a helmet, such as a cycle or skiing helmet.

If you don't have these items - in addition to this area on your pass - you will not be able to access the pitlane during any session.

CIRCUIT MEDIA SHUTTLES

There are regular media shuttles that run around the circuit perimeter urban road during the event. The start and finish times for this service will be posted on the notice boards in the both Media Centre. The pick up point is at the entrance of the circuit, between the cafeteria and the museum. Please refer to the event map.

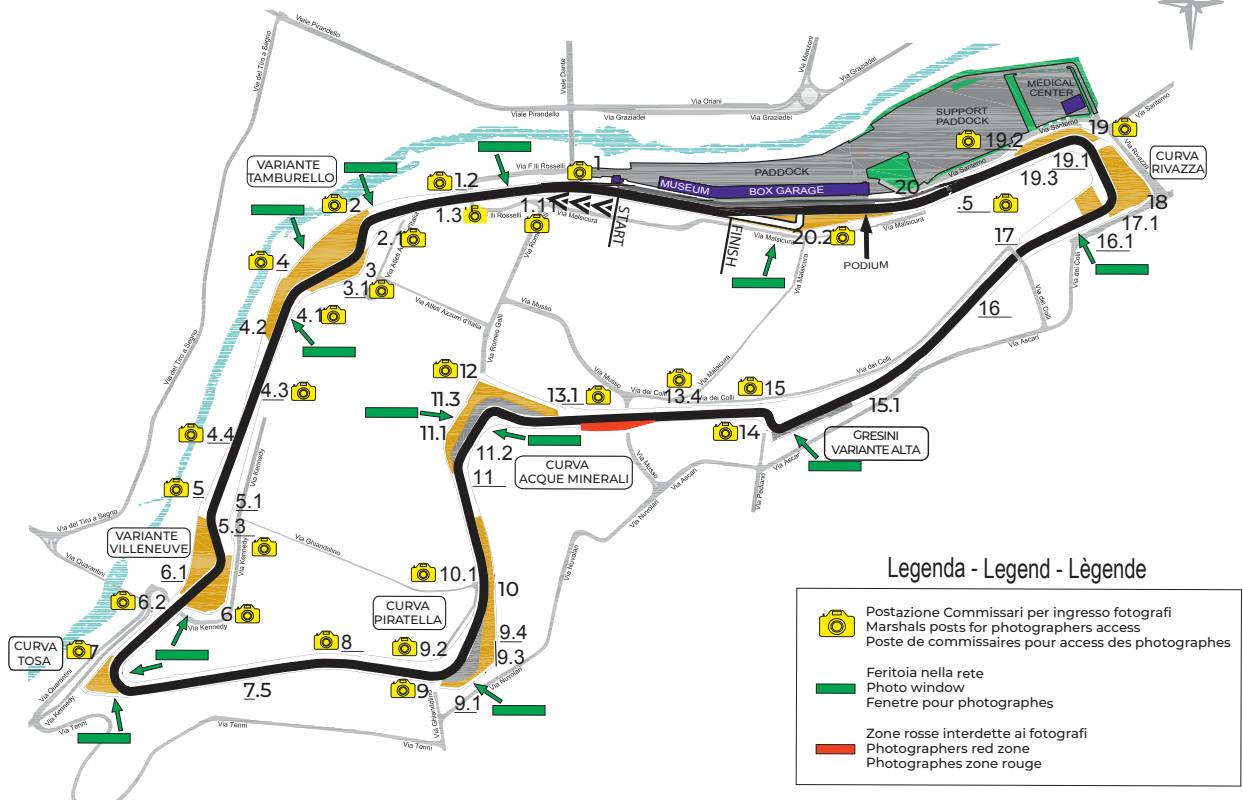
